

SAWMILL BLADE SHIPPING CHECKLIST

Use this checklist before shipping your sawmill blades to Cutting Edge Sawmill. A little preparation helps protect the blades in transit, keeps the package easier to handle, and helps us get started on your sharpening and setting service faster.



BEFORE YOU PACK

Make sure each blade is safely coiled and secured before placing it in the box. Wear gloves while handling blades, protect the teeth from rubbing against other blades or the box, and avoid sending loose blades that can spring open during shipping.

SAWMILL BLADE SHIPPING CHECKLIST

- ✓ Clean off heavy sawdust, pitch, and loose debris
- ✓ Coil each blade securely
- ✓ Tie or fasten each coil so it cannot spring open
- ✓ Protect the blade teeth and sharp edges
- ✓ Stack blades neatly inside the box
- ✓ Use a sturdy box that fits the coiled blades closely
- ✓ Fill empty space so the blades cannot shift
- ✓ Seal the box securely with strong packing tape
- ✓ Include your name and contact information inside the package
- ✓ Complete your blade service request before shipping
- ✓ Attach your shipping label securely
- ✓ Keep your tracking number until your blades arrive

AVOID THESE SHIPPING MISTAKES



LOOSE BLADES

Do not place unsecured coils in the box where they can spring open.



OVERSIZED BOXES

Too much empty space allows blades to move and can increase shipping cost.



POORLY PROTECTED TEETH

Blade teeth rubbing together or against the box can cause unnecessary damage.
